What's 4-H camp like?

A typical day begins with wake-up about 7am and a hearty breakfast. Everybody pitches in after breakfast to keep the camp in tip-top condition. Campers gather around the flag pole for morning flag raising. The morning is filled with fun classes. In the afternoon, campers join friends for swimming, free-time, recreation, and team meetings. After supper, everyone comes together for the flag lowering ceremony and night activities such as pool party, mega relay, recreation, and campfire. Cabin lights are turned off about 10:30 p.m.

Where do we sleep?

In air conditioned cabins!!! There is a cabin area for boys on one side of the campground and a girls' cabin area on the other side. Each cabin holds 8-14 people. At least one adult stays in every cabin. Campers live in the same cabin with other kids from their school and Warren County.

What classes can I choose from?

Due to COVID restrictions, campers will be rotating classes with their own cabin. The classes will be Agriculture, Archery, Boating, Crafts, Fishing, Low Ropes, Nature, Rifle, Sling Shot, Swimming and Zip Line//Climbing Wall. The classes will be 1 hour 15 minutes each.

What about the food?

We provide three meals per day plus snacks. Examples are french toast sticks, biscuits & gravy, cereal bar, salad bar, chicken strips, hamburger, and tacos.
